The Texas Real Estate Commission will hold a series of five public forums providing an opportunity for its licensees and members of the public to make recommendations on the development of its Strategic Plan for fiscal years 2007-2011. The forums will be held in Austin, Houston, Lubbock and Fort Worth during February.

Every two years Texas state agencies are required to review and update their five year Strategic Plan, a road map for the direction in which the agency intends to proceed. Any requests for additional appropriations or changes in existing state law advocated by the agency must be referenced to its Strategic Plan. Individuals are invited to attend, participate, and share ideas on what the agency should be doing, what it should not be doing, and what it should be doing differently.
