The Texas Real Estate Commission and the Texas Appraiser Licensing Certification Board are pleased to announce the agency will be live streaming its quarterly meetings from Austin to the world via the internet for the first time this month.

The agency has continuously strived to increase agency transparency and providing better access to Commission and Board meetings have been a top priority. Previously, full recordings of these meetings were uploaded to the agency's web site and available for playback at any time. With advancements in technology and the agency's new facilities, future Commission and Board meetings will be streamed live. This means real time access to the meeting in its entirety, allowing every license holder and the public, no matter their location, the opportunity to watch the meetings as they happen.

Access to the meeting can be found on the agency's website by clicking "Meetings & Agenda" on the left hand side of the agency's home page. There is no special software to download, but live streaming will work best with a high speed internet connection. The Commission meets in Austin on August 13 at 10 a.m. and the Board meets in Austin on August 17 at 10 a.m.
