AUSTIN, TX - The Texas Real Estate Commission (TREC) is pleased to announce the reappointment by Governor Rick Perry of Avis Wukasch and Adrian Arriaga to the Commission. Ms. Wukasch was reappointed as the TREC Chair and Mr. Arriaga was reappointed to serve as a broker member of the Commission. In addition to these two reappointments, the Governor appointed Chart Westcott of Dallas to serve as a public member of the Commission.

Avis Wukasch was first appointed by the Governor to serve as Chair of TREC in June of 2011. She was honored as Texas' Realtor of the Year in 2011, currently serves on the National Association of Realtors (NAR) Legal Review Committee, and has been active in various other NAR committees and task forces over many years. In 2007, Wukasch was named Chairman of the Board for the Texas Association of Realtors, the largest professional membership organization in the state. A native Texan, Wukasch earned a B.S. in political science from the University of Texas - Austin. She has been team leader for Keller Williams Williamson County Market Center since April 2001.

Adrian A. Arriaga, CCIM, CIPS of McAllen is an International Commercial Broker and Owner of AAA Real Estate & Investments. He currently serves as the NAR President's Liaison to China, and previously served in the same capacity as the liaison to Mexico. He was elected to the Executive Committee of the Certified Commercial Investment Member Institute (CCIM), where he serves as an instructor. He is also an instructor in the Certified International Property Specialist Program (CIPS). Arriaga received a Bachelor's degree and a Master's degree in political science from Texas A&M University, and served as a commissioned officer in the U.S. Army.

Attorney Chart Westcott of Dallas serves as general counsel of Commodore Partners and is Chairman of the Westcott Foundation, a private organization focusing on improving education and economic conditions in Dallas. He currently serves as Texas Chairman of the National Association to Protect Children, is on the Advocacy Board of the United Way of Metropolitan Dallas and is a member of Economic Policy Committee of the Dallas Regional Chamber of Commerce. Westcott is also a member of the Federalist Society, the Dallas Bar Association, the American Bar Association, and the North Texas Crime Commission. He earned his bachelor's degree in history from Vanderbilt University and his law degree from the Dedman School of Law at Southern Methodist University.
