**APPLICATION FOR
EASEMENT OR RIGHT-OF-WAY AGENT REGISTRATION BY AN INDIVIDUAL**
(PLEASE READ ALL INFORMATION CAREFULLY)

To obtain an active Texas real estate easement or right-of-way agent registration, a person must: (1) complete and file an application and (2) go through a criminal history background check. If the applicant's fingerprints are on file for TREC, a subsequent background check will be conducted.

An applicant who has not been previously fingerprinted for TREC must pay a fee to DPS to get fingerprinted and go through a criminal history background check. **Each registration is required by law to have fingerprints on file with the Department of Public Safety (DPS) for TREC. Fingerprints on file for other agencies will not be accepted.** The registration will issue once all requirements are met and TREC receives confirmation from DPS that the applicant's fingerprints are on file. The applicant will be required to pay a fee for a background check with each renewal. For additional information regarding fingerprinting requirements, including scheduling an appointment, please visit www.trec.texas.gov. The digital fingerprinting process may take up to 10 days, so plan accordingly. An applicant must pay a registration fee AND a fingerprint or background check fee.

ALL REQUIRED FEES MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH THE APPLICATION. AN APPLICATION SUBMITTED WITHOUT THE APPROPRIATE FEES WILL BE REJECTED AND RETURNED. All fees should be paid by **CASHIERS CHECK, PERSONAL CHECK OR MONEY ORDER** payable to the Texas Real Estate Commission. **DO NOT PAY WITH CASH.**

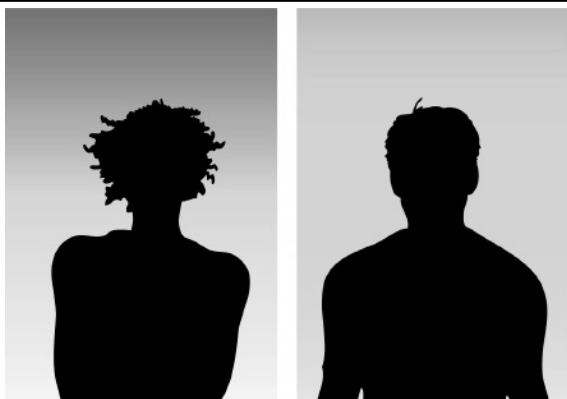
