Instructor and students interact face to face and in real time, in either the same physical location, or through the use of technology.	Courses are presented as a series of lessons on a web browser or mobile device which can be accessed anytime and anyplace. Some providers refer to combination courses as combo, blended or hybrid. At least 50% of a combined qualifying course must be offered by classroom delivery.
