Apprentice Inspector License Application

(Please read all information carefully)

This application must be filed with a Texas Professional Inspector who is qualified to sponsor applicants and who currently holds an active license. Both the applicant and the sponsoring Professional Inspector must sign this application. All correspondence regarding this application will be copied to the sponsoring inspector. The application is not transferable. A sponsoring Professional Inspector cannot be changed during the processing of an application. If an applicant desires a different sponsoring Professional Inspector, a new application and fees must be filed with the Commission.

- 1. To be eligible to file an application for an Apprentice Inspector license, an individual must be a citizen of the United States or a lawfully admitted alien and eighteen (18) years of age or older.
- 2. Each license holder is required by law to have fingerprints on file with the Department of Public Safety (DPS) for TREC to satisfy the statutory requirement for honesty, trustworthiness, and integrity. **Fingerprints on file for other agencies will not be accepted.** For more information on fingerprinting requirements, including scheduling an appointment, please visit www.trec.texas.gov. A license will not issue until fingerprint requirements have been met and a background check has been cleared.
- 3. All required fees must be submitted at the time of filing an application. An application received without the appropriate fees will be rejected and returned. The fees should be submitted in one cashiers check, personal check or money order payable to the Texas Real Estate Commission.

4. Apprentice inspector applicants must provide proof of professional liability insurance, a surety bond, or any other guaranty that provides coverage for violations of Texas Occupations Code, Chapter 1102, Subchapter G, on the TREC Certificate of Insurance or Proof of Financial Responsibility Form before a license will issue.

ALL REQUIREMENTS FOR A LICENSE MUST BE MET WITHIN ONE YEAR OF THE APPLICATION FILING DATE, OR THE APPLICATION EXPIRES.
